

FIRST AID IN CASE OF SLURRY GAS POISONING

The first thing you have to do: Carry the victim outside in fresh air and call an ambulance

Next steps: **1** CHECK IF THE VICTIM IS UNCONSCIOUS

- Talk to him
 - Shake him-
- If he is awake, keep him awake until the ambulance arrives

2 IF THE VICTIM IS UNCONSCIOUS

Check if he is breathing by listening to his nose and mouth



IF THE VICTIM IS UNCONSCIOUS AND NOT BREATHING

Open his airway by tilting his head backwards.
If necessary, clean his nose and mouth.



IF THE VICTIM IS UNCONSCIOUS AND BREATHING

Open his airway, place him in recovery position and wait for the ambulance.



IF THE VICTIM IS STILL NOT BREATHING - GIVE RESCUE BREATHS

RESCUE BREATHS BY MOUTH-TO-MOUTH METHOD

Tilt the victim's head backwards.

Kneel on both knees next to his head.

With your mouth wide open blow air into his nose and check that his chest rises.

Let go of his face and take a deep breathe, check that his chest lowers.

Keep his head tilted backwards. Blow again.

The first 10 blows must follow each other rapidly, and then continue at normal breathing speed until the ambulance arrives or he breathes on his own.



WHEN THE UNCONSCIOUS PERSON BREATHES NORMALLY AGAIN

Place him in recovery position, stay with him and await the ambulance.
