Registration of winter cereal and oilseed rape and pulses varieties in Landsforsøg® 2025/2026

SEGES Innovation P/S opens for registration of winter cereal (wheat, barley, rye and triticale), winter oilseed rape and broad bean varieties, you wish to have tested in the Danish national trials (Landsforsøg®) in the growing season 2025/2026. It is required that all provided seed corresponds to the seed marketed as C2, respectively C1 for rye regarding composition and quality.

Please be aware of that **transgenic varieties cannot be registered** for the Danish national trials (Landsforsøg®). In case of interest please contact SEGES Innovation to hear about possibilities of special agreements for this type of trial.

Deadline for registration and delivery of seed:

The prerequisite for a deadline placed so late is that most varieties are registered before the end of the deadline as well as seed delivery takes place as early as possible. Already registered varieties can be deregistered at the very latest at the corresponding registration deadlines named above.

The pricing must be considered preliminary as the final pricing for 2025/2026 has not yet been determined. The final price can therefor deviate from the prices shown in this letter.

Seed contamination by transgenic seeds

Delivered seed must be free of contamination by transgenic seed. If detected at a later time that contamination of the seed is possible, SEGES Innovation must be informed. This could cause that the according plots will be destructed.

Testing of variety mixes

Variety mixes in winter wheat that should be tested in the Danish national trials (Landsforsøg®) can be registered in the form "Registration of variety mixes of winter wheat".

Variety mixes in other crops than winter wheat can be registered together with solo varieties.

Please send 25 kg of each variety included in the variety mix. The mix should be composed of equal amounts (thirds/fourths) of each variety, kg to kg. Preferable we receive ready mixed seed. In case this is not possible seed can be mixed locally.

A-plus. Varieties registered for VCU trials at Tystofte Fonden, can be registered for supplementary trials at SEGSES Innovation (A-plus). When a variety is registered as A-plus, the registering representative also agrees to that results from VCU trials are published together with the results from SEGSES Innovation.

Among other places results will be part of the publication "LANDSFORSØGENE 2026".

Note that hybrid varieties of winter rye may not be registered as A-plus if marketed with meddling of line varieties and is tested in VCU trials without meddling.

(B) and other varieties. All other varieties and variety mixes to be tested under Danish conditions. This includes varieties that already are part of the official Danish variety list or varieties with potential interest for the Danish market.

Among other places results will be part of the publication "LANDSFORSØGENE 2026".

SEGSES Innovation reserves the right not to conduct trials if less than four B varieties and no A varieties are registered.

From 2025 the number of trials for **winter faba beans** will be increased from 3 to 4 trials.

In winter oilseed rape, one additional trial will be established in the VCU program and one additional national trial to ensure more approved trials. Therefore, there is an extraordinary price increase for the testing of winter oilseed rape varieties. However, the price increase only reflects the establishment of the additional trials. If all trials can be carried out as planned, a further increase will follow.

It is possible to register winter wheat varieties to add to an existing organic variety trial conducted at four locations. The price per variety is 16,500 DKK.

It will also be possible to register for organic variety trials in winter rye where the price per variety will depend on the number of registered varieties. A minimum of five registered winter rye varieties is required before trials can be carried out. Organic variety trials with winter rye will be conducted at three locations, and the price per variety (if five varieties are registered) will be 25,000 DKK.

Registration for organic VCU testing continues to go through TystofteFonden.

- 1) An additional fee of 4.340 DKK is charged for varieties that are not yet registered on the official Danish variety list for participation in observation plots.
- 2) Testing of winter rye varieties with short straw is offered under following conditions:
 - a. At registration of a minimum of three short strawed varieties, these will be tested in an individual trial setup, however with the identical reference variety mix as for the regular rye varieties. The price will correspond to the price given for regular winter rye varieties.
 - b. At registration of less than three short strawed varieties of winter rye, these will be included in the regular trial set up for winter rye. Short strawed varieties will be screened of with border plots to either side of a short strawed rye variety. Due to the high number of borders plots the price for testing will be raised to double compared to regular winter rye varieties, shown in the price list. Additionally, more seed will be required. SEGES Innovation will contact the according applicant to discuss further details.
- 3) Registration price if 5 varieties are registered. If more varieties are registered the price will be adjusted accordingly

The very latest date for receiving of seed of winter oilseed rape is August 6th 2025, for winter barley and rye is September 1st, 2025. For all other crops it is September 8th, 2025.

As far as possible include the following information for each batch, preferably on the outside of the bag: germination rate and thousand kernel weight (TKW). If the information on germination rate is not included a standard of 95% will be used for calculations.

If a variety is tested in different trials, we prefer to receive seed from the same batch.

We reserve the right to refuse seed received past the deadline unless special arrangements have been made beforehand with Leif Hagelskjær.

If the seed is received too late or not at all, SEGES Innovation reserves the right to charge the above listed registration fee.
