## Can the sow manage one more litter?

Examine each sow systematically after each round of farrowing. For instance, use the below criteria when assessing whether a sow can manage having one more litter. The sow does not necessarily have to meet all criteria, and you weight the individual criteria yourself according to your experiences/desires.

Check the sow card for remarks concerning the sow's behaviour.



Are the piglets large and uniform? Take into account whether the sow has functioned as a nurse sow.



Sow in medium condition. Check the feed box to see whether the sow has had a large appetite.



Count the number of well-functioning teats on the sow.
