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^{*} The calf is fresh. No further aktivity is performed.

^{**} The calf is in the middle group, where closer examination is required to determine whether the calf is sick or not. Cough is induced and rectal temperature is measured. If these two aktivities scores one cross or more in total, the calf is placed in the red category.

^{***} The calf i sick and the herd veterinarians directkions for treatment should be followed. If more than 25-30% of the calves in a group pen or a housing unit are sick, there is a significant likelihood that many more calves will be sick in a short time, and a more substantial strategy should be implemented.

^{****}This line enables the "calve screener" to evaluate the calf after treatment by inducing a second screening of the calf. The interval between treatment and evaluation will typically be 3-4 days, but this must be directed by the herd veterinarian.
