Avoid remains of hypodermic needles

When the needle has broken

Step 1:

Immediately remove the remains of the needle, if these are visible.

If it is not possible to remove the needle, **immediately** mark the animal.

Step 2:

Contact the settlement office of the slaughterhouse **immediately** concerning earmarking.

Step 3:

Contact the settlement office of the slaughterhouse before delivery.



Correct injection technique

The injection method depends on the medication and appears from the bottle.

- i.m.: intramuscular - injection in the musculature.
- s.c.: subcutaneous - injection under the skin.



Only use detectable needles !

5 good pieces of advice

Only use detectable needles.

- The needles must be approved by DMA, the Danish Meat Research Institute
- Every batch must be approved separately
- Batch no. must appear from the invoice
- Check batch no. at <u>www.danishmeat.dk/view.asp?ID=12620</u>

Always use correct needle size. Always have spare needles ready for use. Never use bent needles - discard them! Discuss injection techniques and hygiene with the vet.



Correct use of needles

Piglets (iron injection):	0.8 mm × 10 mm
Weaners up to 15 kg:	1.1 mm × 25 mm
Finishers:	1.6 mm × 25 mm

Sows and boars: $1.6 \text{ mm} \times 35 \text{ mm}$

Always discard blunt needles.

Change needles

- After every litter in the farrowing facility.
- After every 5-10 treatments of weaners and finishers.
- After 1-2 treatments of sows.

Always clean the needles after use. Do not leave the needle in the medicine bottle.
